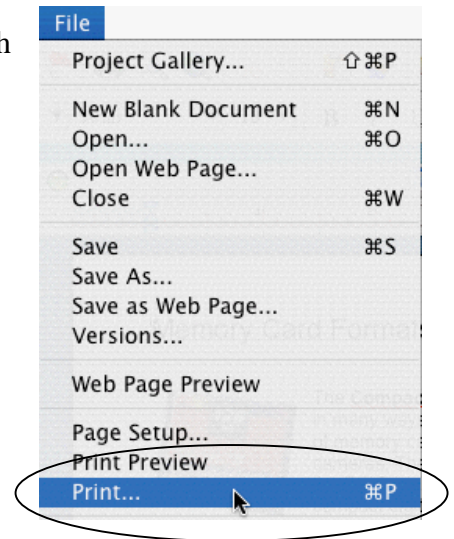


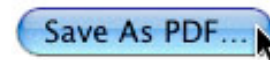
Mac OSX Print to PDF File

Portable Document Files (PDF) are cross-platform files that are read with one of the various versions of Adobe Acrobat. These include Acrobat Reader, Adobe Reader, Acrobat Approval and the full Adobe Acrobat. Generally, to creating a PDF version of a file requires the full Adobe Acrobat. However, Mac OSX has PDF capability built into the system.

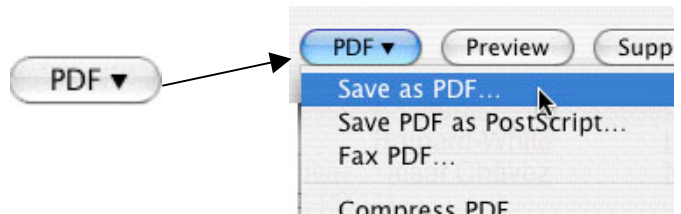
1. Open the file you want to PDF, click on the File menu and drag down to Print.



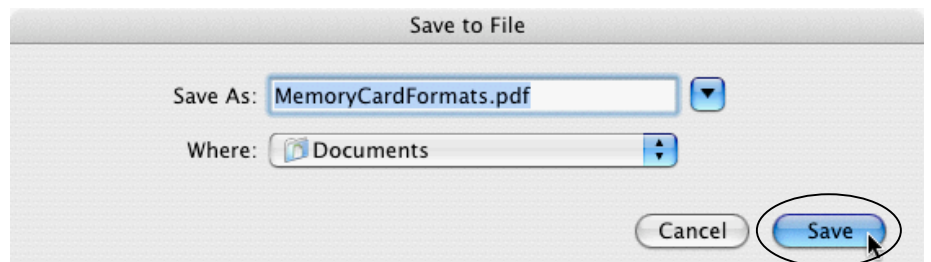
2. On the earlier OSX systems there will be a Save As PDF button. Click the Save As PDF button.



On the new OSX system there will be a PDF button. Click the button to show a pull-down menu, and select Save as PDF,

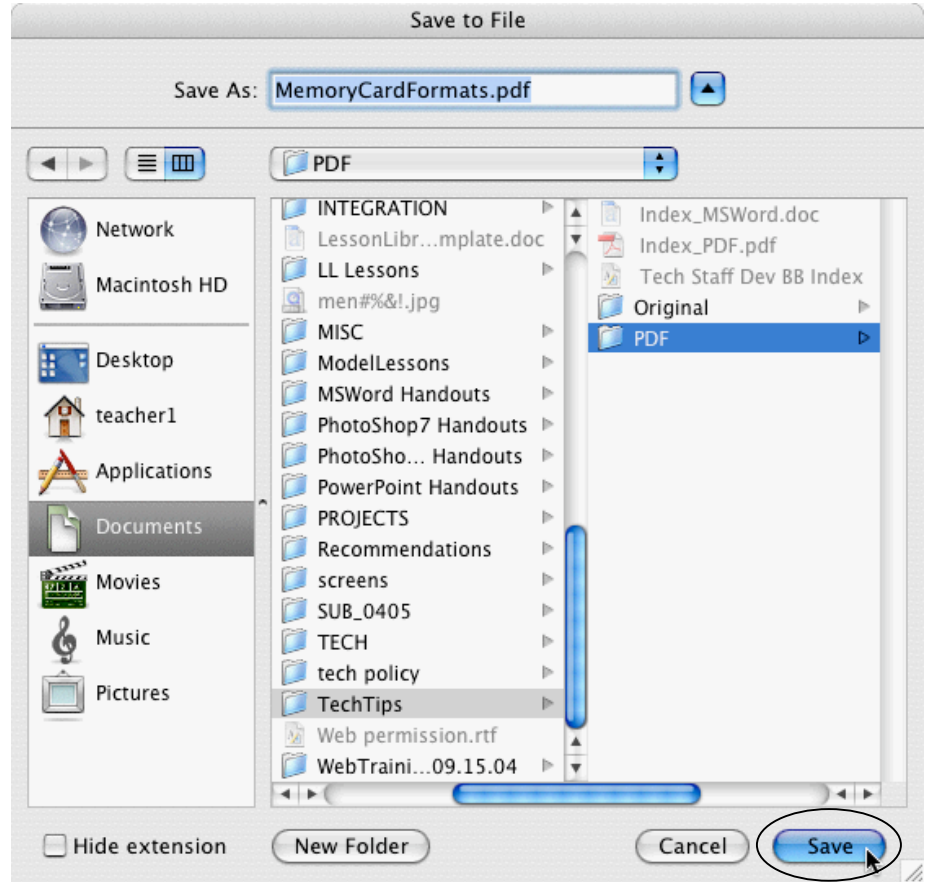


3. In Simple Save mode, change the filename extension to .pdf and click the Save button. For more control over the save location, click the triangle to the right of the Save As field.

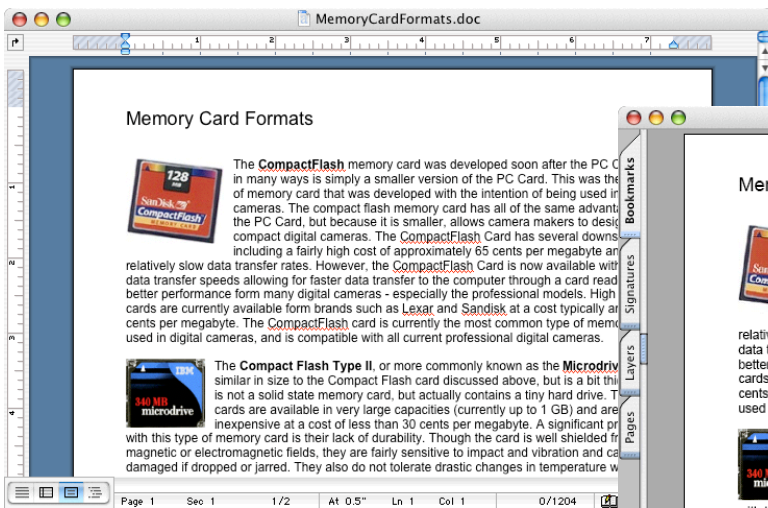


Mac OSX Print to PDF File
